We seeks to promote safer, less vulnerable communities with the capacity to cope with hazards and disasters.

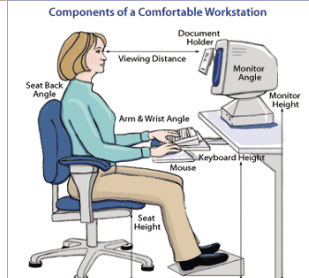
